



CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

Inari is committed to being an ethical business, ensuring all materials contained in its products are responsibly sourced and does not purchase conflict minerals from mines in the conflict region.

Inari adopts a sourcing policy that ensure the tantalum (Ta), tin (Sn), gold (Au) and tungsten (W), used in its products do not benefit the armed groups that perpetrate human right abuses in the Democratic Republic of Congo and the surrounding around.

Inari expects each of our suppliers to do all following:

- ❖ Refuse the use conflict minerals come from Democratic Republic of Congo and its surrounding area.
- ❖ Implement due diligence processes to ensure that he tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold minerals used in their products do not come from areas.
- ❖ Suppliers must pass this requirement through their supply chain.
- ❖ Suppliers must report using the CFSI template <http://www.conflictreesourcing.org/conflict-mineral-reporting-template/> and by working together seeks to achieve a conflict-free supply chain by only working with those suppliers whose businesses are compliant.
